## Gift Aid Scheme

The Gift Aid scheme gives an extra 25p in every £ pound that donors give to charity, if the donor pays UK tax, without costing the donor any more.

For example if you donate £10, Rosie's Helping Hands receives £2.50 on top of that from the Gift Aid Scheme which makes your donation worth £12.50 without costing you more than £10.

**Gift Aid Guidance:** Charities can reclaim tax paid on donations made by individual taxpayers under the Gift Aid scheme. The donor must pay an amount of Income Tax and/or Capital Gains Tax for a tax year (06 April to 05 April) at least equal to the repayment claimed on their donations by all the charities and Community Amateur Sports Clubs (CASCs) to whom the donor donates in that tax year. Other taxes such as VAT and Council Tax do not qualify.
